



To achieve the **District Citation for 2024-25** complete **8** of the following by June 30, 2025. Check the ones your club has accomplished and send to your Assistant Governor by June 15th. Activities are to be completed between July 1st, 2024, and June 15th, 2025. Inform and inspire your club by talking about Rotary’s Action Plan and theme, celebrate with your membership at a club forum or general assembly.

	1. Enter goals into MY ROTARY for Membership, Foundation and Polio in the Rotary Club Central Goal Center. Review quarterly.
	2. Tell your stories of service and contribution by entering at least 2 into the Rotary Club Central portal under Service Activities.
	3. Get to know your members! Have a minimum, 10% of members to create a profile in My Rotary and present to club how “The Magic of Rotary” has impacted their life.
	4. Host a Rotary Youth Exchange student or sponsor a student to participate in Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) or another youth initiative.
	5. Participate/collaborate in an environmental project in your community.
	6. Share the Magic of Rotary on September 11 by participating in the District Day of Service or organize a club or area clubs equivalent on an alternate date.
	7. Membership, host an event for members, alumni, not-yet Rotarians, and have a goal of plus 3 for your club.
	8. Celebrate your community and members with PAUL HARRIS Recognitions.
	9. Participate in Conference 2024 at the Nottawasaga Inn & Resort in Alliston Ontario, https://district7010conference.com/ have 2 members or 10% of Club Members attend.
	10. End Polio NOW campaign is Rotary’s #1 corporate initiative! Host an event/walk on October 24th and post on media and highlight Rotary’s role! Share with DG Steve to be part of a collage at District 7010 Foundation Dinner 2024/25. Increase Polio Plus Society membership by one member or have 10% of club members contribute or have 100% of club members contribute some amount to Polio Plus fund.
	11. Educate your club about WHY we need to contribute to the Rotary International Foundation, and have 80% of members participate in Every Rotarian, Every Year (\$25 US/year). Input your goals for the Annual Fund and Polio Plus in Rotary Club Central.
	12. Rotary is Global! Highlight Rotary opportunities for international travel and have a minimum 1 member participate in an international opportunity: International Convention, Friendship exchange, or service with Rotary.
	13. Represent! Give a presentation to highlight the roles at District 7010, have at least one club member participate on a District Committee.
	14. Engage and encourage at least 30% of club members participate in at least one learning opportunity via the District and Rotary International resources: Learning Center, Rotary Weekend, Zone Conference, District Conference, Learning Institute.
